**Urban\_Wins** (“Urban metabolism accounts for building Waste management Innovative Networks and Strategies”) (project no. 690047) aims to develop and test methods for designing and implementing innovative and sustainable Strategic Plans for Waste Prevention and Management in various urban contexts based on innovative, inter-disciplinary and participatory approaches. These will enhance urban environmental resilience and will guarantee progress towards more sustainable production and consumption patterns together with improvements in the recovery of waste and the use of recovered materials.
